(Our W.:M.: is out working with the York Rite family (Grand York Rite in Levenworth) this month, so he requested that I just report on our scheduled events. -Ed.)

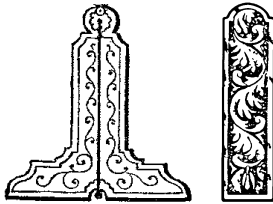
Starting out our June Activities will be an Entered Apprentice double degree (a father and his son) on the 3rd of June, starting at 7:00 pm

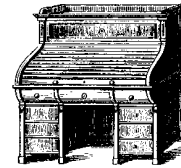

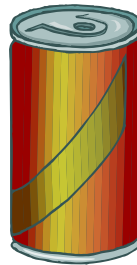

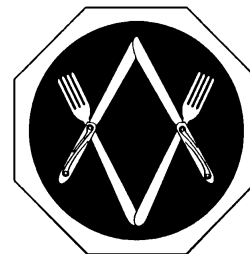
