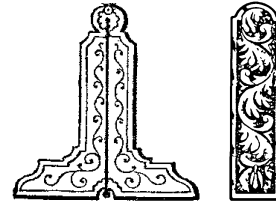
Our August stated meeting will be "Awards Night" and our Jobies are fixing a special dinner for us. We need you attendance at that meeting to honor our award recipients.

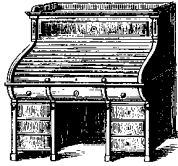

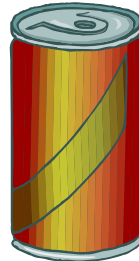

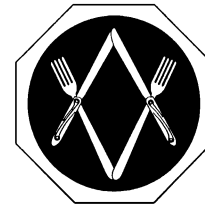
