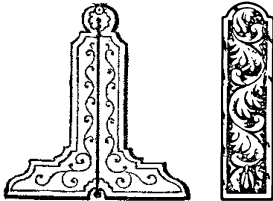


FROM THE EAST:

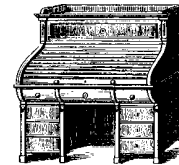

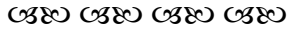

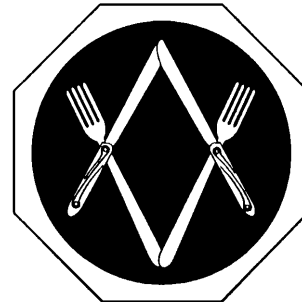
